


Origami : a penguin



Material

- a black isosceles triangle
(base : 10 cm - sides : 11 cm)
- a white isosceles triangle
(base : 10 cm - sides : 11 cm)
- scissors
- glue stick



- Stick the two triangles back to back.
- Fold in two the obtained triangle with the black faces together.



- At 5,5 cm high, fold the triangle's tip in order that the bottom of the folded part becomes parallel with the base.
- For help, look at the picture.
- Use your fingers to mark the fold.



- Put the tip up straight and then open slightly the triangle.
- Push the tip towards the black inside following the folds and reversing them.
- Mark the new folds with your fingers.



- *Move the beak tip up slowly.*
- *Move it right.*
- *Make a fold between the beak and the tip of the wings.*



- *Continue the movement pushing the beak towards the other side until one fold is created in the middle.*
- *Squeeze it.*



- *Fold the wings forwards making the fold tip corresponding to the middle of the triangle.*
