


# Polar jumping jacks ... bear or reindeer ?

(8-12 years old)

## Material

*white and thick drawing printer paper  
a punch, scissors, glue, 8 claps, string  
a pin in order to pierce paper and something to color.*




*Click on the previous page to print the model*



*Cut the printed forms carefully.*

*Color the snout in black, stick it on the head, then draw the eyes.*

*Stick the tip of the paws and draw a black line to mark the separation.*





*With the punch, make holes in the paws and in the body like on the model.*



*With a pin, make a hole in each paw.*

*On the picture, crosses indicate the exact location. Look good !*



*Thread the string through the little paws like on the picture.*

***!!! Pay attention to the paws direction!!!***

*Then pass the string a first time through the big paw.*

*Go back making a loop and pass a second time in the same hole.*

***!!! with the pin, enlarge the hole if necessary!!!***

*Do the same with the last paw.  
You have to obtain the same thing as on the picture.*



*Hook the bear's paws to its body by putting the claps in the holes.*

*!!! Don't squeeze the claps to much, the paws have to move !!!*

*Adjust the lenght of the string like on the picture.*



*Stick the head*
