At the end of this narrative, the children will understand that the current manner of living, wasting energy and water, will have grave consequences on future generations.

They will also make simple changes to their lives to contribute directly to safeguarding the planet.

The last sentence of the narrative "And are you already contaminated?" will open the door to deeper discovery of the subject.

She took a deep breath in and then dove. Next she darted back to the surface under Tiphok and blew out a spray of water. Tiphok found himself projected three meters above the sea.


- "You hang onto my fins and take your nap on my back!" she said in a deep voice.

- On a blue base representing the sea, stick every crystals together so the ice floe recreates itself little by little. The more gestures we promise, the bigger and more beautiful the ice floe.
- Then to put life on the ice floe adding seals and pinguins only created with circles (see craft column).
- !!! If you prefer to draw bears on the ice floe, don't put pinguins !!!

 Bears life in the North pole and pinguins in the South pole. They never meet each other.

 There are seals in the North pole and the South pole.
